We begin and end the Canadian Rockies Adventure in Seattle so we can facilitate Customs and arrival into Canada and return to the U. S. as a group instead of individually.

Your son/daughter MUST have the following items with them to get into Canada and to return to the U.S.:

- **A PASSPORT.** Regulations have tightened at U.S. borders, and a passport IS REQUIRED to travel to Canada. This is a new restriction, and in years past the border has been more lenient.

- **THIS LETTER OF INTENT (REVERSE).** This is simply a letter from the legal parents or guardians granting permission for a minor to enter Canada, along with information on the nature of the visit. To simplify things for you, we have provided a form (on the back of this sheet) in which you fill in the blanks and return to our office. Both parents (not step-parents) must sign this form for legal permission.

Please make two copies of your passport's inside front cover.
Keep one copy at home, and attach the second copy here.
